The Harry Fox Agency and INgrooves Enter Download Licensing Arrangement

June 25, 2007 - The Harry Fox Agency, Inc. (HFA), a leading U.S. music rights licensing organization announced today that it has entered into a licensing arrangement with INgrooves, a leading digital distributor and administrator of independent music, for full-length, permanent digital downloads.

HFA added over 50 new licensees to its bulk licensing program for permanent digital downloads (DPDs) in 2006, bringing the number of companies participating in this program to over 600.
